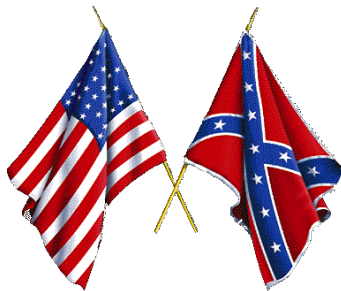

ACCC Convention attendees and their families are welcome to join him now for a free costumed tour of the battlefield on Friday, October 28. Visitors will learn about Gen. Robert E. Lee, Gen. George Meade, Abraham Lincoln, Jennie Wade, the “Rolling Chaplain,” and a number of other characters. The tour will also include an artillery demonstration and a digital scavenger hunt. Minimal walking is necessary (mostly getting out of your car at each stop and walking a few yards to the assembly area).
